Reasons and Considerations

1. Having regard to the location of the site within a rural area under Strong Urban Influence as identified in the “Sustainable Rural Housing Guidelines for Planning Authorities” issued by the Department of the Environment, Heritage and Local Government in April, 2005, and to National Policy Objective 19 of the National Planning Framework (February 2018) which, for rural areas under urban influence, such as the current case, seeks to facilitate the provision of single housing in the countryside based on the core consideration of demonstrable economic or social need to live in the rural area, having regard to the viability of smaller towns and rural settlements, and by reference to the rural housing provisions of the current Galway County Development Plan, it is considered that the applicant, has not sufficiently demonstrated an economic or social need to live in

níl an Bord sásta nach bhféadfaí freastal go sásúil ar riachtanais tithíochta an iarratasóra i mbaile nó sráidbhaile/ionad lonnaíochta seanbhunaithe. this rural area having regard to the viability of smaller towns and rural settlements in accordance with national policy. In this regard, the Board is not satisfied that the applicant's housing needs could not be satisfactorily met in an established smaller town or village/settlement centre. Therefore, the proposed development does not comply with National Policy Objective 19, the provisions of the 2005 Guidelines and Objective RHO4 of the Galway County Development Plan 2015-21, would contribute to the encroachment of random rural development in the area and would militate against the preservation of the rural environment and the efficient provision of public services and infrastructure. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to the ministerial guidelines and to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

2. Having regard to the high water table on site and the information set out in the site characterisation report submitted with the application, the Board is not satisfied, based on the submissions made in connection with the application and the appeal, that the proposed development, taken in conjunction with existing development in the vicinity, would not significantly and negatively impact on the environment and would not result in an excessive proliferation and concentration of developments in the area served by wastewater treatment systems and discharging to the groundwater. It is considered, therefore, that the proposed development would be prejudicial to public health.
