Application for an Extension of Time to Apply for Substitute Consent by Lawrence Behan care of Golder Associates Ireland Limited of Town Centre House, Dublin Road, Naas, County Kildare pursuant to the determination by South Dublin County Council on the 13th day of August, 2012, requiring the owner/operator to apply to An Bord Pleanála for substitute consent.

Development: Quarry at Windmill Hill, Rathcoole, County Dublin.

Decision

Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, for a Further Period of 12 Weeks from the date of this Order, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the current circumstances and ongoing restrictions related to measures to combat the Covid-19 virus, the Board agreed to provide a further extension of time to the applicant, totalling 12 weeks from the date of this Order, in relation to the requirement to submit an application for substitute consent.
