

Board Order ABP-309764-21

Appeal by Brendan Thornton care of Shay Scanlon Architect of Kilmore, Kilcock, County Meath in relation to the application by Meath County Council of the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme made for the area in respect of conditions numbers 18 and 19 of its decision made on the 22nd day of February, 2021.

Proposed Development: Construction of part two-storey, part single storey detached dwellinghouse with first floor terrace to the rear, detached garage, new vehicular entrance gateway, new access road, new waste water treatment unit and polishing filter, along with all associated services, service connections, landscape and site development works at Mayne, Clonee, County Meath.

Decision

The Board, in accordance with section 48 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, considered, based on the reasons and considerations set out below, that the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme for the area had been properly applied in respect

of conditions numbers 18 and 19 and directs the said Council to ATTACH conditions numbers 18 and 19 and the reasons therefor.

Reasons and Considerations

The Board, in accordance with section 48 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, considered that the terms of the Meath County Council Development Contribution Scheme for the area had been properly applied in respect of condition number 18 and condition number 19 and directs the Council to attach condition number 18 and condition number 19.
