APPEAL by Paul Groden care of Keith O'Connell of Cox's Yard, Distillery Road, Westport, County Mayo against the decision made on the 30th day of March, 2021 by Mayo County Council to refuse permission for the proposed development.

Proposed Development: Change of house location, site boundaries and site entrance to previously granted under P16/748 together with all ancillary stie works at Mucklagh, Carrowholly, Westport, County Mayo.

Decision

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

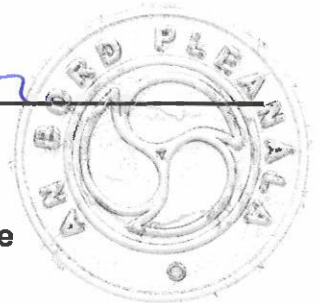
Having regard to the topography of the site, the elevated positioning of the proposed dwelling, together with its scale and design, and the resulting extensive excavation and ground alteration, it is considered that the proposed development would form a discordant and obtrusive feature on the landscape at this location, would extend an existing pattern of ribbon development, would seriously injure the visual amenities of the area, would fail to be adequately absorbed and integrated into the landscape, would militate against the preservation of the rural environment and would set an undesirable precedent for other such prominently located development in the vicinity. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
