Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by

virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made

thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any

submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory

provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the established pattern of development in the area and its

zoning for residential use under objective 'Z1' of the Dublin City Development

Plan 2016 - 2022, and to the nature and scale of the development proposed

for retention, which would be ancillary to the established residential use of the

site, it is considered that, subject to compliance with the conditions set out

below, the development proposed for retention would not injure the residential

amenities of property in the vicinity of the site and would be in keeping with

the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

Conditions

1. The development proposed for retention shall be in accordance with the

plans and particulars lodged with the application, except as may

otherwise be required in order to comply with the following condition.

Reason: In the interest of clarity.

 Water supply and drainage arrangements, including the attenuation and disposal of surface water, shall comply with the requirements of the planning authority for such works and services.

Reason: In the interest of public health.
