

Board Order ABP-310546-21

WHEREAS a question has arisen as to whether the industrial extraction of peat at Baltrasna Bog, Mullingar, County Westmeath is or is not development or is or is not exempted development:

AND WHEREAS the question was referred to An Bord Pleanála by Westmeath County Council on the 17th day of June, 2021:

AND WHEREAS An Bord Pleanála, in considering this referral, had regard particularly to -

- (a) Sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended,
- (b) articles 6(1) and 9(1) of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001, as amended,

- (c) Schedules 2, 5 and 7 to those Regulations,
- (d) the planning history of the site, and
- (e) the pattern of development in the area:

AND WHEREAS An Bord Pleanála has concluded that -

- (a) the industrial extraction of peat is development, being both works and material change of use of land, and
- (b) the industrial extraction of peat is not exempted development, because of the location, nature and scale of the works which require both Environmental Impact Assessment and Appropriate Assessment:

NOW THEREFORE An Bord Pleanála, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 5 (4) of the 2000 Act, hereby decides that the industrial extraction of peat at Baltrasna Bog, Mullingar, County Westmeath is development and is not exempted development.
