

## Board Order ABP-310672-21

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2020

**Planning Authority: Donegal County Council**

Application for Leave to Appeal against the decision of the planning authority by Damien Donnelly and Others care of 1 Hillview, Luddan, Buncrana, County Donegal having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which Donegal County Council decided on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2021 to grant subject to conditions a permission to Martin Quinn care of Dominic Whoriskey of Main Street, Newtowncunningham, County Donegal.

**Proposed Development:** Construction of two number dwellinghouses, with connection to existing public services and all associated site works at Luddan, Buncrana, Lifford Post Office, County Donegal.

## Decision

REFUSE leave to appeal under section 37 (6) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.



## **Matters Considered**

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

## **Reasons and Considerations**

Having regard to the submissions and documents received in connection with the application for leave to appeal and the conditions set out in the planning authority's decision, it is considered that it has not been shown that the development in respect of which a decision to grant permission has been made will differ materially from the development as set out in the application for permission by reason of conditions imposed by the planning authority to which the grant is subject.
