Appeal by Eircom Limited care of Entrust Limited of Unit 1D Deerpark
Business Centre, Oranmore, County Galway against the decision made on
the 1st day of July, 2021 by Waterford City and County Council to refuse
permission for the proposed development.

Proposed Development: The installation of a 21 metres monopole carrying antennas, a dish, associated equipment, together with ground-based equipment cabinets and all associated site development works for wireless data and broadband services at Eir Exchange, Ballynamona Upper, Dungarvan, County Waterford.

Decision

GRANT permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the said plans and particulars based on the reasons and considerations under and subject to the conditions set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the provisions of the Waterford County Development Plan 2011 (as varied and extended), particularly Section 10.39 'Telecommunications' and Objectives INF 24 and INF 13, and the Telecommunications Antennae and Support Structures Guidelines for Planning Authorities issued by the Department of the Environment and Local Government in 1996 (as updated by Circular Letter PL 07/12), it is considered that, subject to compliance with the conditions set out below, the proposed development would not seriously injure the amenities of the area, or result in a significant negative residential or visual impact on the surrounding vicinity. The proposed development would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

Conditions

The development shall be carried out and completed in accordance with the plans and particulars lodged with the application, except as may otherwise be required in order to comply with the following conditions. Where such conditions require details to be agreed with the planning authority, the developer shall agree such details in writing with the planning authority prior to commencement of development and the development shall be carried out and completed in accordance with the agreed particulars.

Reason: In the interest of clarity.

 Landscaping of the site shall be carried out in accordance with a landscaping scheme which shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of the visual amenities of the area.

 Details of the proposed colour scheme for the telecommunications structure, ancillary structures and fencing shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of the visual amenities of the area.

A low intensity fixed red obstacle light shall be fitted as close to the top 4. of the mast as practicable and shall be visible from all angles in azimuth. Details of this light, its location and period of operation shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of public safety.
