Application for an Extension of Time to Apply for Substitute Consent by Mark Phelan care of Enviroguide Consulting of Unit 3D, Core C, Block 71, The Plaza, Parkwest, Dublin pursuant to the determination by An Bord Pleanála on the 16th day of June 2021, granting the owner/operator leave to apply to An Bord Pleanála for substitute consent.

Development: Quarry at Maplestown, County Carlow.

Decision

Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, until the 8th day of November 2021, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.



Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

The Board noted the request made for an extension of the period for the making of the application for substitute consent in this instance, arising from the unavailability of various contractors as a result of Covid 19 restrictions. It is considered that an extension until the 8th day of November 2021 would be reasonable and appropriate to enable completion of application documentation to the necessary standard.
