Proposed Development: Retention and completion of single storey extension to rear of existing dwellinghouse at 'Eddy Stone', Cooney's Field, Ballinluska, Myrtleville, County Cork.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the nature and extent of the extension to be retained and

completed and to the pattern of development in the area, it is considered that

the development, subject to compliance with the conditions set out below,

would not seriously injure the residential or visual amenities of the area or of

property in the vicinity and would, therefore, be accordance with the proper

planning and sustainable development of the area.

Conditions

The development shall be retained and completed in accordance with 1.

the plans and particulars lodged with the application, as amended by the

further plans and particulars received by the planning authority on the 8th

day of July, 2021, except as may otherwise be required in order to

comply with the following conditions.

Reason: In the interest of clarity.

Drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, shall 2. comply with the requirements of the planning authority for such works.

Reason: In the interest of public health.

3. Site development and building works shall be carried out only between the hours of 0700 to 1900 Mondays to Fridays inclusive, between 0800 to 1400 hours on Saturdays and not at all on Sundays and public holidays. Deviation from these times will only be allowed in exceptional circumstances where prior written approval has been received from the planning authority.
