

Board Order ABP-311757-21

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2021

Planning Authority: Kerry County Council

APPEAL by John O'Neill care of B&J Rochford of 19 Henry Street, Kenmare, County Kerry against the decision made on the 27th day of September, 2021 by Kerry County Council to refuse permission.

Proposed Development: Renovate and extend existing dwelling with new attached garage, treatment unit, sand polishing filter and all associated site works to facilitate the development at Derreenaclaurig, Sneem, County Kerry.

Decision

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the conditions pertaining on site, Board is not satisfied, on the basis of the submissions made in connection with the application and appeal, that the proprietary effluent treatment system and raised polishing filter proposed to serve the proposed extended dwelling is adequate to treat effluent arising from the proposed development in a manner that would not give rise to the risk of pollution to surface water and/or ground water. The proposed development would, therefore, be prejudicial to public health.
