

## Board Order ABP-312050-21

**Derelict Sites Act, 1990** 

Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2022

**Planning Authority: Carlow County Council** 

**Application** received by An Bord Pleanála on the 25<sup>th</sup> of November, 2021 from Carlow County Council pursuant to section 16 of the Derelict Sites Act, 1990, as amended, for consent to the compulsory acquisition of a derelict site known as 12 Burrin Street, County Carlow, and as more particularly described in the notice of intention to compulsorily acquire the site.

## Decision

GRANT consent to the compulsory acquisition of the said site based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

## **Reasons and Considerations**

Having regard to the derelict state of the site and its neglected, unsightly and objectionable condition, the Board considers that the site detracts to a material degree from the amenity, character and appearance of land in the neighbourhood and, therefore, comes within the definition of a derelict site as defined in section 3(b) of the Derelict Sites Act 1990, as amended, and that the compulsory acquisition of the site by the local authority is necessary to render the site non-derelict and to prevent it from continuing to be a derelict site. It is also considered that the objection made against such acquisition cannot be sustained, having regard to that said necessity.
