## Board Order ABP-312351-22

**Derelict Sites Act, 1990**

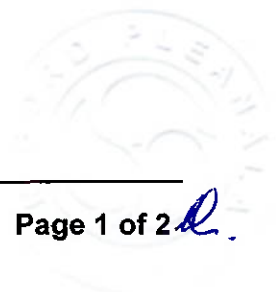
**Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2022**

**Planning Authority: Limerick City and Council**

**Application** received by An Bord Pleanála on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2021 from Limerick City and County Council pursuant to section 16 of the Derelict Sites Act, 1990, as amended, for consent to the compulsory acquisition of a derelict site at Saint Rita's, Lower Hartstonge Street, County Limerick and as more particularly described in the notice of intention to compulsorily acquire the site.



### Decision

**GRANT** consent to the compulsory acquisition of the said site based on the reasons and considerations set out below.



## Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the neglected, unsightly and objectionable condition of the site, the poor state of repair of the external wall at parapet and top floor levels it is considered that the site detracts to a material degree from the amenity, character and appearance of land in the neighbourhood and, therefore, comes within the definition of a derelict site as defined in sections 3(a) and 3(b) of the Derelict Sites Act, 1990, as amended, and that the acquisition of the site by the local authority is necessary in order to render the site non-derelict and to prevent it continuing to be a derelict site. It is also considered that the objection made cannot be sustained having regard to that said necessity.
