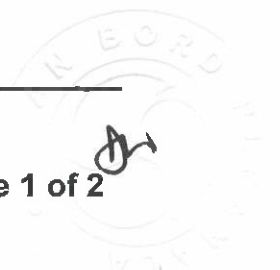




## Matters Considered

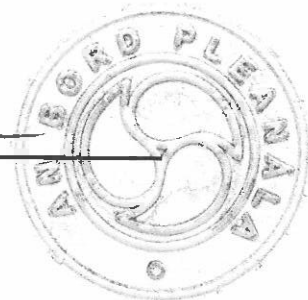
## Reasons and Considerations

The Board noted the request made for an extension of the period for the making of the application for substitute consent in this instance, arising from the unavailability of various technical resources as a result of Covid 19 restrictions and the complexity of preparing the impact statements. It is considered that an extension of time until the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2022 would be reasonable and appropriate to enable completion of application documentation to the necessary standard.
