Planning Authority: Donegal County Council

Application for an Extension of Time to Apply for Substitute Consent by Ian Tinney (trading as Tinney's Quarry) care of Joe Bonner Town Planning Consultants of The Airport Hub, Unit 1, Furry Park, Old Swords Road, Santry, Dublin pursuant to the determination by An Bord Pleanála on the 19th day of November, 2021, granting the owner/operator leave to apply to An Bord Pleanála for substitute consent.

Development: Quarry at Trentaghmucklagh, Saint Johnstown, County Donegal.

Decision

Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, for a Further Period from the end of the original 12 week period that commenced on the 19th day of November, 2021, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

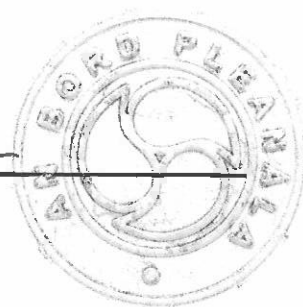
Reasons and Considerations

The Board noted the request made for an extension of the period for the making of the application for substitute consent in this instance, arising from the need to complete the necessary work and studies to prepare the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and Natura Impact Statement, in particular in relation to ongoing monitoring of groundwater and boreholes. It is considered that an extension of time until the 20th day of June 2022 would be reasonable and appropriate to enable completion of application documentation to the necessary standard.
