

Board Order ABP-313052-22

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2022

APPEAL by Brian Walsh and Niamh Hynes Walsh of Avoca Lodge, Farnanes, County Cork against the decision made on the 18th day of February, 2022 by Cork County Council to refuse permission.

Proposed Development: Change of use of one number duplex residential unit to short-term holiday letting at 2 Market Place, Kinsale, County Cork.

Decision

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development for the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

The site is located in a designated Rent Pressure Zone which is characterised by a high demand for housing, high rent inflation and a limited supply of longterm accommodation available. Having regard to the central and accessible location of the site, the character and nature of the mixed-use area, and the nature and extent of the accommodation within the apartment, which is considered suitable for long-term letting, it is considered that the proposed change of use to short-term letting would result in the loss of a residential unit in an area of high demand for such units, which would exacerbate the existing shortage of availability of long-term rented accommodation within Kinsale and the Bandon Kinsale Electoral Area Rent Pressure Zone. The proposed development would contravene the overarching Government National Housing Policy to regulate short-term letting and to return properties to the long-term housing market and would be inconsistent with the Government's Housing For All Policy and the Joint Housing Strategy in the Cork County Development Plan 2022-2028, which seeks to provide for a diverse range of housing needs to suit varying income levels and social circumstances. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
