

Board Order ABP-313119-22

Planning Authority: South Dublin County Council

Application for Leave to Appeal against the decision of the planning authority by Kevin Kelly of 2 Fairgreen, Saggart, County Dublin having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which South Dublin County Council decided on the 28th day of February, 2022 to grant subject to conditions a permission to Coffey Construction Limited care of Rowan Engineering Consultants Limited of Unit 14, Scurlockstown Business Park, Trim, County Meath.

Proposed Development: Land recontouring/infilling works on circa 38,000 square metres of a folio size of circa 5.3 hectares (allowing buffers). The volume of material to be placed on the site circa 91,000 cubic metres with an average fill level of circa 3.5 metres above existing, at Saggart, County Dublin.

Decision

REFUSE leave to appeal under section 37 (6) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.
