Application for an Extension of Time to Apply for Substitute Consent by John Madden and Sons care of Tobin Consulting Engineers of Fairgreen House, Fairgreen Road, Galway pursuant to the determination by An Bord Pleanála on the 31st day of March, 2022, requiring the owner/operator to apply to An Bord Pleanála for substitute consent.


Development: Quarry at Ballysheedy, Gort, County Galway.

Decision

Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, for a further period from the end of the original 12 week period that commenced on the 31st day of March, 2022, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

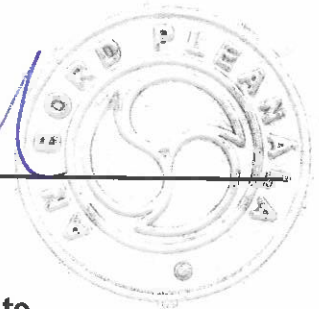
Reasons and Considerations

The Board noted the request made for an extension of the period for the making of the application for substitute consent in this instance, arising from the need to complete the necessary work and studies to prepare the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and Natura Impact Statement. It is considered that an extension of time until the 14th day of July 2022 would be reasonable and appropriate to enable completion of application documentation to the necessary standard.
