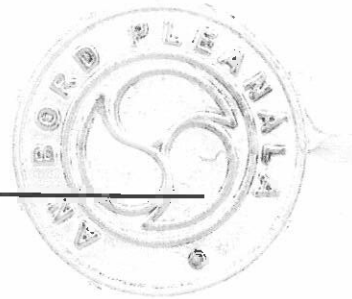
## Reasons and Considerations
