

Board Order ABP-313753-22

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2021

Planning Authority: Donegal County Council

Application for an Extension of Time to Apply for Substitute Consent by lan Tinney (trading as Tinney's Quarry) care of Joe Bonner Town Planning Consultant of The Airport Hub, Unit 1, Furry Park, Old Swords Road, Santry, Dublin pursuant to the determination by An Bord Pleanála on the 19th day of November, 2021, requiring the owner/operator to apply to An Bord Pleanála for substitute consent.

Development: Quarry at Trentnaghmucklagh, Saint Johnstown, County Donegal.

Decision

Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, for a further period, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

The Board noted the request made for an extension of the period for the making of the application for substitute consent in this instance, arising from the need to complete the necessary work and studies to prepare the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and Natura Impact Statement, in particular in relation to ongoing monitoring of groundwater and boreholes. It is considered that an extension of time until the 18th day of July, 2022 would be reasonable and appropriate to enable completion of application documentation to the necessary standard.
