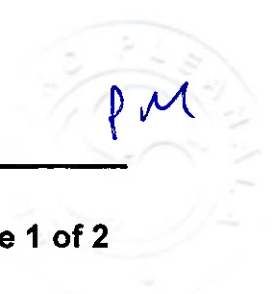

APPEAL by Vantage Towers Limited care of Charterhouse Infrastructure Consultants of 27 Market Street, Listowel, County Kerry against the decision made on the 15th day of June, 2022 by Galway City Council to refuse permission.

Proposed Development: Erection of a 24-metre-high telecommunications lattice structure together with antennas, dishes, headframe and associated telecommunications equipment all enclosed by security fencing and construction of new access track at Barna, Cappagh Road, County Galway.

Decision

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the reasons and considerations set out below.



Reasons and Considerations

The Board considered that the alternative long-term track and alternative entrance to the site as submitted by the developer, which the Board considered a material change to the proposed development, did not form part of the original application and public notices and was not included in the red line boundary of the original application.

In deciding not to accept the Inspector's recommendation to grant permission, the Board was not of the view that the entrance and access as originally submitted could be delivered as proposed and the alternative access and access route did not form part of the application notice.
