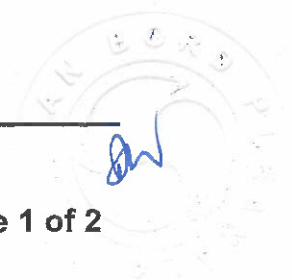

Application for an Extension of Time to Apply for Substitute Consent by Ian Tinney (trading as Tinney's Quarry) care of Joe Bonner of The Airport Hub, Unit 1, Furry Park, Old Swords Road, Santry, Dublin pursuant to the determination by An Bord Pleanála on the 24th day of June, 2022, granting an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent to An Bord Pleanála.

Development: Quarry at Tinney's Quarry, Trentnaghmucklagh, St. Johnstown, County Donegal.

Decision

Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, for a further period, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.



Reasons and Considerations

The Board decided to grant a further extension to the timeframe for the lodgement of the application for substitute consent under section 177D of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, to the 31st day of August 2022, having regard to the ongoing finalisation of necessary work and studies to complete the preparation of the remedial Environmental Impact Assessment Report and remedial Natura Impact Statement, and to the intervening period falling within the general summer holiday period.
