

Board Order ABP-314712-22

Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2021

Planning Authority: Galway County Council

APPLICATION by Atlantic Troy Limited requesting An Bord Pleanála to consider and determine, in accordance with its powers under article 120(3)(cc) of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001, as amended, whether the local authority should be directed to prepare an Environmental Impact Assessment Report in respect of a new fire station at St. Lawrencesfields, Athenry Road, Loughrea, County Galway.

DECISION

NOT TO DIRECT the local authority to prepare an Environmental Impact Assessment Report in respect of the said proposed development based on the reasons and considerations set out below.
