

Board Order ABP -314943-22

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2022

Planning Authority: Dublin City Council

Planning Register Reference Number: WEB1744/22

Appeal by Louise White and Alan Brady care of Found Architecture of 37 North Great Georges Street, Dublin against the decision made on the 6th day of October, 2022 by Dublin City Council to grant subject to conditions a permission in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council.

Proposed Development: The removal of the existing rear extension, construction of new single storey rear extension and dormer attic conversion, and associated site works at 87 Iveagh Gardens, Dublin.

Decision

Having regard to the nature of the condition the subject of the appeal, the Board is satisfied that the determination by the Board of the relevant application as if it had been made to it in the first instance would not be warranted and, based on the reasons and considerations set out below, directs the said Council under subsection (1) of section 139 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 to REMOVE condition number 2 and the reason therefor.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the nature and scale of the proposed development, its end of terrace location and the limited views of the development available from the public realm, it is considered that condition number 2 is not required in order to ensure the proposal would not seriously injure the residential or visual amenities of the area. It is considered that the proposed development would, therefore, be in accordance with the provisions of the Dublin City Development Plan 2022-2028 and the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
