Application for Leave to Appeal against the decision of the planning authority by Noel O'Toole care of Frank Ross of Blossom Hill, Kilcornan, County Limerick having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which Limerick City and County Council decided on the 11th day of October, 2022 to grant subject to conditions a permission to Mehran Ghanbari care of JS Design of Ashcroft, 30 Cuil Fuine, Lisloose, Tralee, County Kerry.

Proposed Development: Retention of continued use of building as a gym and all associated signage at King's Gym, St. Joseph Street, Limerick.

Decision

REFUSE leave to appeal under section 37 (6) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations
