Proposed Development: Retain change of use of residential dwellinghouse to short-term rental accommodation with all associated ancillary works at Ballyaglisha, Ballyferriter, Dingle, County Kerry.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the suitability of the property for permanent housing due to its size, layout, generous amenity areas, as well as its location within a cluster of residential development within walking distance of Ballyferriter Village, it is considered that the dwellinghouse would be suitable as a place of permanent residential occupation. In the absence of sufficient evidence to the contrary, it is considered that the proposed retention of change of use from residential to short-term holiday letting would contravene Policy 10.3.5.3 and related Objective KCDP 10-34 of Chapter 10 (Tourism and Outdoor Recreation) of the Kerry County Development Plan 2022-2028, and would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
