

Board Order ABP-316495-23

Appeal by Sharon and Jason O'Brien care of Foresight Design and Planning of Grangebellew, Drogheda, County Louth against the decision made on the 30th day of March, 2023 by Louth County Council to refuse permission.

Proposed Development: Retention of an existing outbuilding/garden shed to the rear of the property, use of shed for domestic living accommodation to be decommissioned, and all associated site development works, all at 183 Marian Park, Drogheda, County Louth.

Decision

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development for the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

The Board had regard to the Louth County Development Plan 2021 - 2027, including Section 13.9.10 concerning outbuildings within the curtilage of residential properties that will have a use incidental to the dwelling. In this case, the Board is not satisfied that sufficient information has been presented regarding the nature of use of the outbuilding/garden shed to justify the design and significant scale of the building proposed for retention. It is considered that the retention of the development would, therefore, not be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

In deciding not to accept the Inspector's recommendation to grant permission, the Board had regard to the absence of information concerning the need for an outbuilding/garden shed of this quantum and design at this location.
