
**Development:** Quarry at Recess, Lissoughter, County Galway.

**Decision**

**Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, for a Further Period of six months from the end of the original 12 week period that commenced on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of June , 2023, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.**

## Reasons and Considerations

The Board noted the request made for an extension of the period for the making of the application for substitute consent. It is considered that an extension of time for a period of six months from the end of the original 12 week period would be reasonable and appropriate to allow for appropriate technical studies and collection of data to be undertaken by the applicant and its consultants to allow for the completion of the remedial Environmental Impact Assessment Report and remedial Natura Impact Statement.
