

## Board Order ABP-317725-23

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2022

**Appeal** by Grace Cuthbertson of 29 Spencer Villas, Glenageary, County Dublin against the decision made on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2023 by Dún-Laoghaire Rathdown County Council to grant subject to conditions a permission to Audrey Behan and Alan Kerr, care of Ryan and Lamb Architects of 41 Lower Baggot Street, Dublin.

Proposed Development The development will consist of (1) the partial removal of the existing boundary wall between Sunny Bank and Garryowen; (2) the demolition of the existing conservatory to the rear of Sunny Bank and the construction of a new single storey extension, internal alterations and the inclusion of new external finishes, windows and rooflights; (3) the demolition of existing side passage to Garryowen and the construction of a new two-storey extension to link Garryowen and Sunny Bank to form a single dwelling, internal alterations and the addition of new photovoltaic panels to the roof at the rear; (4) site works to include gate widening to Sunny Bank to a width of 3.4 metres, relocating the existing bicycle/bin store to the front of Garryowen, landscaping, barbeque area to rear of Sunny Bank and associated ancillary site works and services, all at Garryowen, Spencer Villas, Glenageary, County Dublin and Sunny Bank, Spencer Villas, Glenageary, County Dublin.
