

Board Order ABP-317853-23

Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2022

Planning Authority: Sligo County Council

APPLICATION by Cathal and Jacqueline Quigley of Drumfin via Boyle, County Sligo requesting An Bord Pleanála to consider and determine, in accordance with its powers under article 120(3)(cc) of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001, as amended, whether Sligo County Council should be directed to prepare an Environmental Impact Assessment Report in respect of the construction of a Strategic Road Maintenance Facility and all associated site development works, landscaping and associated drainage including associated on site effluent treatment system, at Drumfin, County Sligo.
