

Board Order ABP-318159-23

Appeal by Adrian Moughty care of Hughes Planning and Development Consultants of 85 Merrion Square, Dublin against the decision made on the 6th day of September, 2023 by South Dublin County Council to grant subject to conditions a permission in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council.

Proposed Development: 38-square metre flat roof ancillary garden studio located to infill irregular space at rear (western side) of existing garden along with associated site works at 10 Foxborough Crescent, Lucan, County Dublin.

Decision

Having regard to the nature of the condition the subject of the appeal, the Board is satisfied that the determination by the Board of the relevant application as if it had been made to it in the first instance would not be warranted and, based on the reasons and considerations set out below, directs the said Council under subsection (1) of section 139 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, to REMOVE condition number 3 and the reason therefor.
