

## Board Order ABP-318635-23

**Derelict Sites Act, 1990** 

Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2022

**Planning Authority: Limerick City and County Council** 

**Application** received by An Bord Pleanála on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November 2023 from Limerick City and County Council pursuant to section 16 of the Derelict Sites Act, 1990, as amended, for consent to the compulsory acquisition of a derelict site at Canal Bank House, Off Lelia Street, County Limerick, and as more particularly described in the notice of intention to compulsorily acquire the site.

## **Decision**

REFUSE consent to the compulsory acquisition of the said site based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

## **Reasons and Considerations**

Notwithstanding the current unsightly and objectionable condition of the site which detracts to a material degree from the amenity, character and appearance of the surrounding land in the neighbourhood, taking account of the evidence of the ongoing efforts being made by the notice party to address the dereliction on site, the board does not consider it reasonable that the local authority now seeks to compulsorily acquire the land as provided by Section 14 of the Derelict Sites Act, 1990, and that sufficient time was not afforded to the notice party to resolve matters. In disagreeing with the recommendation of its Inspector to grant consent to the compulsory acquisition, the board noted that a further planning application lodged by the notice party was currently before the local authority for adjudication.
