

Board Order ABP-318821-24

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2022

Planning Authority: Cavan County Council

Planning Register Reference Number: 23/272

Appeal by Michael O'Neill care of Drumacarrow Residents of Drumacarrow Castle, Drumacarrow, Bailieborough, County Cavan and by others against the decision made on the 15th day of December, 2023 by Cavan County Council to grant subject to conditions a permission to On Tower Ireland Limited care of Indigo of Raheen Business Park, Limerick in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council.

Proposed Development: Installation of a 24 metre multi-user lattice type telecommunications support structure, carrying antenna and dishes enclosed within a 2.4 metre high palisade fenced compound together with associated ground equipment cabinets and associated site works, including a new access track on lands at Drumacarrow, Bailieborough, County Cavan. Further public notices were received by the planning authority on the 20th day of November, 2023.

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Decision

GRANT permission for the above proposed development in accordance

with the said plans and particulars based on the reasons and

considerations under and subject to the conditions set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the guidance for locating telecommunications masts in the

Telecommunications Antennae and Support Structures - Guidelines for

Planning Authorities issued by the Department of the Environment, Heritage

and Local Government in 1996 and policies and objectives of the Cavan

County Development Plan 2022-2028, it is considered that, subject to

compliance with the conditions set out below, the proposed development

would not seriously injure the visual or residential impact on the properties in

the vicinity of the site and would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper

planning and sustainable development of the area.

Conditions

1. The development shall be carried out and completed in accordance with

the plans and particulars lodged with the application, as amended by the

further plans and particulars submitted, except as may otherwise be

required in order to comply with the following conditions. Where such

conditions require details to be agreed with the planning authority, the

developer shall agree such details in writing with the planning authority

prior to commencement of development and the development shall be

carried out and completed in accordance with the agreed particulars.

Reason: In the interest of clarity.

 Details of the proposed colour scheme for the pole, antenna and equipment containers shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of the visual amenity of the area.

3. Surface water drainage arrangements for the proposed development shall comply with the requirements of the planning authority.

Reason: In the interest of public health.

4. Site development and building works shall be carried out only between the hours of 0800 to 1900 Mondays to Fridays inclusive, between 0800 to 1400 hours on Saturdays and not at all on Sundays and public holidays. Deviation from these times will only be allowed in exceptional circumstances where prior written approval has been received from the planning authority.

Reason: In order to safeguard the residential amenities of property in the vicinity.

 The developer shall provide and make available on reasonable terms, the proposed mast for the provision of mobile telecommunications antennae/dishes of third party licensed mobile telecommunications operators.

Reason: To avoid unnecessary proliferation of telecommunications structures in the landscape, in the interest of visual amenity.

6. The developer shall be responsible for the full cost of repair in respect to any damage caused to the public road arising from construction work and shall either make good any such damage forthwith to the satisfaction of the planning authority or pay the planning authority.

Reason: In the interest of road traffic safety.

7. A low intensity fixed red obstacle light shall be fitted as close to the top of the mast as practicable and shall be visible from all angles in azimuth. Details of this light, its location and period of operation shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of public safety.

8. Details of the proposed colour scheme for the telecommunications structure, ancillary structures and fencing shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority prior to commencement of development.

Reason: In the interest of the visual amenities of the area.

9. All existing hedgerow along the access track save for the section shall be removed, as specified in the submitted plans and shall be protected during construction, and permanently retained thereafter.

Reason: In the interest of visual amenity and the protection of wildlife habitats.
