Application for Leave to Appeal against the decision of the planning authority by Maher Plant Hire care of Ensuir Architects and Engineers of 51-53 Queen Street, Clonmel, County Tipperary, having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which Tipperary County Council decided on the 4th day of January, 2024, to grant subject to conditions an permission to Vantage Towers Limited care of Charterhouse HQ of Charterhouse, 27 Market Street, Listowel, Co Kerry.

Proposed Development: A 24-metre-high monopole structure together with antennas, dishes and associated telecommunications equipment, and safety bollards at Sidney Bourke, Burgagery-Lands West, Cashel Road, Clonmel, County Tipperary.
