

Commission Order ABP-322119-25

Appeal by Enda Curran and Karen Browne care of Irene Curran of Rosmoney Pier, Westport, County Mayo against the decision made on the 25th day of February, 2025 by Limerick City and County Council to refuse permission.

Proposed Development: Demolition of the existing agricultural barn and construction of a dwellinghouse, domestic garage, on-site wastewater treatment system, percolation area and connection to existing services together with all ancillary site development works, all at Newtown, Clarina, County Limerick.

Decision

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development for the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

It is the policy of the planning authority, as set out in the Limerick
Development Plan 2022-2028, including Objective CGR O1 and Policy CGR
P3, to control urban sprawl and ribbon development. When taken in
conjunction with existing development in the vicinity of the site, the proposed
development would be contrary to this policy as it would consolidate and
contribute to the build-up of ribbon development and unsustainable urban
sprawl in an open rural area. The proposed development would militate
against the preservation of the rural environment and agricultural lands and
would lead to demands for the provision of urban type services which would
be uneconomic and inappropriate in such a rural setting. The proposed
development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and
sustainable development of the area.
