APPEAL by Michael and Liam Griffin of Ros Roe Island (An Ros), Carraroe, County Galway against the decision made on the 30th day of April 2025, by Galway County Council to grant permission, subject to conditions, to Sean and Stephanie Flaherty care of Eamon Gavin of Dooghty Road, Cornamona, County Galway for the proposed development.

Proposed Development: Retention of changes made to dwelling that differ from the design as granted under planning reference number 20/514. Design changes to be retained include the addition of an attic conversion with rooflights and new double doors to the south gable. Gross floor area of works: 136.10 square metres(H). Gross floor space of retention: 67.30 square metres (attic) at An Ros, Carraroe, County Galway.

Decision

GRANT permission for the above proposed development in accordance

with the said plans and particulars based on the reasons and

considerations under and subject to the conditions set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the Galway County Development Plan 2022-2028, the

location within a rural area, to the nature and scale of the development

proposed to be retained and its relationship with the surrounding area, it is

considered that subject to compliance with the conditions set out below, the

development proposed to be retained would be acceptable and would not

seriously injure the rural, residential or visual amenities of the area or of

property in the vicinity and would be acceptable in terms of design, public

health and impact on the environment. The development proposed to be

retained would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and

sustainable development of the area.

the plans and particulars lodged with the application, as amended by the

further plans and particulars received by the planning authority on the

14th day of March 2025.
