

Commission Order ACP-322820-25

Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended

Planning Authority: Dublin City Council

Planning Register Reference Number: WEB1685/25

Appeal by Dartry Health Club Limited care of Hughes Planning and Development Consultants of 85 Merrion Square, Dublin against the decision made on the 23rd day of May, 2025 by Dublin City Council to refuse permission.

Proposed Development: Extension of time to the temporary retention permission for previously approved planning register reference number 3264/21: Stretched Skin Structure, supported by steel columns, which accommodates silent fitness classes on the grounds of Dartry Health Club; classes to take place Monday - Friday 7am - 8.15pm, Saturday 9am- 4pm, Sunday 10am - 1.20pm; and planning register reference number 3985/22 10-foot shipping container wrapped in artificial foliage to cater for gym classes, and all associated site and landscaping works, all at Dartry Health Club, 31 Palmerston Gardens, Dartry, Dublin.

Decision

REFUSE permission for the above development for the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the location of the site and the proposed removal of all existing car parking, with no supporting mobility strategy or provision of additional cycle parking, it is considered that the development proposed to be retained would give rise to unacceptable levels of overspill and haphazard parking on adjacent residential roads, which would seriously injure the amenities of the area and endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard and obstruction of pedestrians and other road users. The development proposed to be retained would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
