**Housing Act, 1966**

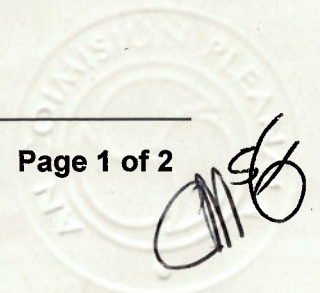

**Applicant: Galway County Council**

**Application** received by An Coimisiún Pleanála on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of July 2025 from Galway County Council pursuant to section 76 of, and the Third Schedule to, the Housing Act, 1966 as extended by section 10 of the Local Government (No.2) Act, 1960 (as substituted by section 86 of the Housing Act, 1966) and the Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2022, for confirmation of a Compulsory Purchase Order authorising compulsory acquisition of lands and entitled **Galway County Council (N63 Abbeyknockmoy Village Active Travel) Compulsory Purchase Order No. 2 2025 (Physical Infrastructure, Fire and Emergency Services and Climate Change)**.


### DECISION
