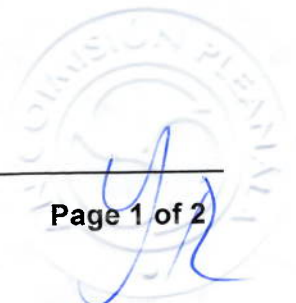

Application received by An Coimisiún Pleanála on the 24th day of July 2026, from Kildare County Council pursuant to section 16 of the Derelict Sites Act, 1990, as amended, for consent to the compulsory acquisition of a site at 38 Curragh Plains, Kildare Town, County Kildare, and as more particularly described in the notice of intention to compulsorily acquire the site.

Decision

REFUSE consent to the compulsory acquisition of the said site based on the reasons and considerations set out below.



Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the objection made to the compulsory acquisition and the letter submitted to An Coimisiún Pleanála by the applicant dated the 20th day of August 2026, seeking to withdraw the said compulsory acquisition, and the documents and submissions on file generally, the Commission considered that it would be appropriate to refuse consent for the compulsory acquisition of the said site.
