

## Board Order 24.CH3247

Local Government (No. 2) Act, 1960

Housing Act, 1966

**Planning Authority: Waterford City and County Council** 

**Application** received by An Bord Pleanála on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2015 from Waterford City and County Council pursuant to section 76 of, and the Third Schedule to, the Housing Act, 1966 as extended by section 10 of the Local Government (No. 2) Act, 1960 (as substituted by section 86 of the Housing Act, 1966) and the Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2017, for confirmation of a compulsory purchase order authorising compulsory acquisition of lands and entitled **Waterford City and County Council**, **Ringnasilloge**, **Co. Waterford Compulsory Purchase Order 2015 (No. 4)**.

## **Decision**

Annul the above compulsory purchase order for the reasons and considerations set out below.

## **Reasons and Considerations**

## Having regard to:

- (a) the objection made to the compulsory purchase order,
- (b) the report of the Inspector who conducted the oral hearing, and
- (c) the documents and submissions on file generally,

it is considered that the acquisition by the local authority of the lands in question is not necessary having regard to the Board's decision to refuse to approve the proposed pedestrian and cycleway under case reference number 24.JP0038.
