

Board Order 01.SH.0235

Application for an Extension of Time to Apply for Substitute Consent by Paul McCann and Stephen Tennant of Grant Thornton (Receivers), 24 to 26 City Quay, Dublin care of Resource Planning Management and Development of 70 Glengarriff Parade, Phibsborough, Dublin pursuant to the determination by An Bord Pleanála on the 7th day of April, 2017, requiring the owner/operator to apply to An Bord Pleanála for substitute consent.

Development: Quarry at Clonmelsh and Garryhundon, Powerstown, County Carlow.

Decision

Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, for a Further Period of Four Weeks from the 28th day of June, 2017, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

The Board noted the request made for an extension of the period for the making of the application for substitute consent in this instance, and taking into account the circumstances pertaining to this case, was of the opinion that an extension of four weeks as requested by the applicant would be reasonable and appropriate to enable completion of application documentation.
