

Board Order 29E.VV.0005

Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015

Appeal by The Office of Public Works of Jonathan Swift Street, Trim, County Meath in accordance with section 9(1) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015 against the entry on the Vacant Sites Register by Dublin City Council on the 12th day of April, 2017 in respect of the site described below.

Description: Corner of Saint John's Road West and Military Road, Dublin.

Decision

The Board in accordance with section 9(3) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015, and based on the reasons and considerations set out below, hereby determines that the above site is not a vacant site within the meaning of that Act.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to:

- (a) the information submitted to the Board by the planning authority in relation to the entry of the site on the Vacant Sites Register,
- (b) the grounds of appeal submitted by the appellant,
- (c) the report of the Inspector, and
- (d) the responses of the planning authority and the appellant to the letter issued by the Board on the 28th day of November, 2017,

the Board considered that it is appropriate that a notice be issued to the planning authority to cancel the entry on the Vacant Sites Register.

In reaching its decision, the Board considered that the site is not a vacant site under section 5(1)(a) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015.
