

Board Order 93.VV.0016

Appeal by Richard and Yvonne Dore care of Gittens Murray Architects Limited of 5 William Street, Kilkenny in accordance with section 9(1) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015 against the entry on the Vacant Sites Register by Waterford City and County Council on the 27th day of July, 2017 in respect of the site described below.

Description: Lands at former Candlelight Hotel, Dock Road, Dunmore East, County Waterford.

Decision

The Board in accordance with section 9(3) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015, and based on the reasons and considerations set out below, hereby determines that the above site is a vacant site within the meaning of that Act.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to:

- (a) the information placed before the Board by the Planning Authority in relation to the entry of the site on the Vacant Sites Register,
- (b) the grounds of appeal submitted by the appellant,
- (c) the report of the Inspector, and
- (d) the need and suitability of the site for housing and the vacant or idle condition of the site,

the Board considered that it is appropriate that a notice be issued to the planning authority to confirm the entry on the Vacant Sites Register.
