Introduction

The Board referred to its previous meeting with the prospective applicant and the record of this meeting. The Board enquired if the prospective applicant had any comments it

wished to submit on the record of this meeting. The prospective applicant advised it had no comments to make.

Discussion

The prospective applicant advised it is currently in the process of reviewing the documentation necessary for an EIA and AA screening determination request from the Board under section 181(2T) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended). The prospective applicant stated a significant volume of documentation has been prepared and it is seeking advice from the Board in relation to the format and presentation of the material.

The Board's representatives advised a screening request is a determination made by the Board to decide if an EIAR and/or AA is required and not an assessment of the content to be contained within an EIAR and NIS. Therefore, the documentation deemed necessary for a screening request would be akin to a non-technical summary and a screening report as per Schedule 7A.

It was also reiterated that the Board would be required to consult with the EPA and the owner/occupier of the site in compliance with the legislation.

The number of hard copies and soft copies to be submitted to the Board were discussed. It was agreed that one hard copy and three digital copies would be sufficient unless otherwise instructed by the owner of the site.

Conclusion

The record of the instant meeting will issue in due course, and it is open to the prospective applicant to consider its next steps.
