

## **ADDENDUM TO INSPECTORS REPORT**

**Re: SU17.SU0078 - Additional Submissions/Responses**

I have made note of the above, received subsequent to my Report dated the 11<sup>th</sup> of July 2014. Note is made of the following responses to the revised rEIS:

- Meath County Council response dated the 18th of July 2014 noted the revised rEIS, was submitted wherein the site area had increased to 4.8ha. They provide the Planning Authority is satisfied that the quarry has not given rise to significant adverse effects on the environment and that ongoing impacts are limited in type and significance and can be remediated as outlined in the rEIS. They are satisfied that no information exists to form a contrary view to that previously expressed on this application. They recommend that substitute consent be granted subject to conditions.
- The Geological Survey of Ireland in their letter dated 21<sup>st</sup> of July 2014 provides that they have no additional comment to make, further to their attached correspondence which provides a map showing the substitute consent area and details of Geological Heritage Boundaries.
- The Inland Fisheries provides that having examined the documents they have no further observations to make.

It is not considered that any of the above raises any new issues that have not previously been covered by my Report.
