In accordance with sub-section 2(b) of 37F of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 as amended, Indaver NV 1/a Indaver Ireland gives notice of its furnishing of significant additional information to An Comisúin Pleanála in relation to the following proposed development:

A 10-year planning permission and a 30-year operational life from the completion of the construction of the proposed development, is sought for a Waste to Energy Facility (waste incinerator with energy recovery) for the treatment of non-hazardous and hazardous waste on a 13.55-hectare site, owned by Indaver Ireland Limited, at Ringsaskiddy, County Cork.

The proposed development was fully described in the original public notice for the application. An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and a Natura Impact Statement (NIS) were submitted as part of this application.

The significant additional information in relation to the effects on the environment of the proposed development was lodged with An Comisúin Pleanála on the 29th August 2025.

(ii) The likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, if carried out.

(iii) The likely significant effects of the proposed development on a European Site, if carried out. Any submissions/observations must be accompanied by a fee of €30 (except for certain prescribed bodies). There is no fee required to make a submission in relation to those parties/individuals who have already made a valid written submission to the Commission regarding the application (original ref. PL 04/P40049). Submissions or observations must be received by the Commission no later than 5.30 p.m. on the **17th November 2025**. Such submissions/observations must also include the following information:

(i) The name of the person making the submission or observation, the name of the person acting on his or her behalf, if any, and the address to which any correspondence relating to the application should be sent.

(ii) The subject matter of the submission or observation, and the application should be sent.

(iii) The reasons, considerations and arguments on which the submission or observation is based in full.

Any submissions or observations which do not comply with the above requirements cannot be considered by the Commission.
