The second quarter figures show that:

- The number of all planning cases received in the second quarter of 2019 was up 9% compared to the same period in 2018.
- Intake of planning appeals was up 2% in Quarter 2 2019 versus the same period last year.
- The number of all planning cases decided (disposed) in Quarter 2 2019 was up by 27% for all types of cases (up 26% for appeals) versus Quarter 2 2018.
