This pilot project operated without any major problems and there was a significant volume of submissions lodged using this channel.  In April 2021, the Board launched its new website. An Bord Pleanála worked very closely with NALA in terms of the content and how information is presented on the site in the context of accessibility. There are enhanced search capabilities with easy access to case information and details of ongoing and upcoming oral hearings.
