Case	Strategic Infrastructure Development application- Proposed 12 turbine windfarm, located on a 140-hectare site located within the townlands of Cappateemore East, Ballycannan West, Ballycannan East, Ballycar South, Ballycar North, and Glennagross in County Clare

Under the provisions of section 135 (2AB) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended, this is a 'Specified Matter only' Oral Hearing i.e. a Limited Agenda Oral Hearing.

This legislative provision provides for the Coimisiún to direct that the Reporting Inspector conducts an Oral Hearing and that he or she shall allow points or arguments in relation to the specified matters only during the hearing.

The specified matter for the purpose of this hearing is-

- the Aviation related issues relevant to Shannon Airport and the Woodcock Hill radar

The purpose of the oral hearing is to allow necessary elaboration, discussion and examination of the specified matter only.

This Hearing will allow participants, who wish to do so, to make further submissions on the specified matter only and to allow the Inspector to seek clarification on any relevant issues arising if required.

Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions or to seek clarification on submissions made at the hearing i.e. those specified matters only. There is no obligation on any participant to make a submission to the hearing or to speak for the full time allocated.

On completion of the Hearing, the Inspector will prepare a report and recommendation on the case for the Coimisiún. The decision on this Strategic Infrastructure Development application will be made by the Coimisiún.

If you intend to provide a written copy of any **new submission** or visual aids when speaking (presentations, maps, photos, etc.), these should be submitted if possible in a digital format to the Coimisiún **in advance of the Hearing and by 5.30pm on Tuesday 18th of November** (Such submissions will be retained on the case file after the hearing).

Submissions presented to this hearing will be recorded by a service provider organised by An Coimisiún Pleanála. You are not permitted to record the proceedings of the oral hearing.

The agenda and order of appearance for the Limited Agenda Oral Hearing is set out below, along with allocated times. Participants should note that this schedule is indicative only and is likely to vary during the course of the hearing. Section 135 (2) of the Planning Act 2000, as amended, requires the Inspector *“to conduct the hearing expeditiously and without undue formality”*. For this reason participants are requested to attend the whole hearing as they may be called to participate at other times and in different order to those set out in the agenda.
