The first quarter figures show that:

- The number of cases received in the first quarter of 2019 was up slightly 0.8% versus the same period last year
- Intake of planning appeals was down 9.7% in Quarter 1 2019 versus the same period last year.
- The number of cases decided (disposed) in Quarter 1 2019 was up by 21.4% for all types of cases (up 11.5% for appeals) versus Quarter 1 2018.
